

Directions

By car:

From the roundabout at junction 21 of the M5, follow signs to Worle and Kewstoke (NOT Weston-super-Mare). Kewstoke and the village hall are signposted. After going through a large housing estate there is a sign that warns of narrow country lanes. Follow the winding lane and signs to Kewstoke and the village hall.

By public transport:

Trains leave Bristol and Taunton every half hour for Weston-super-Mare. There are buses from Bristol to Weston also half hourly. From Weston catch the no.1 Sand Bay bus which stops outside Kewstoke Village Hall. Buses leave from the front of Tesco store half hourly, on the hour and on the half hour. The back of Tesco is visible from the train station - walk through the car park to the road in front and you will see bus stops there.

Alternatively, a taxi from Weston town centre to Kewstoke village hall will cost £8.
