### **About Peace Partners**

### **What will you be doing?**

- Ability to work at a strategic and visionary level whilst understanding the details and complexities of delivery
- The influencing skills needed to bring volunteers, partners and stakeholders along with plans
- Strong communication skills
- Ability to analyse risks and opportunities and take a balanced approach to both
- Have access to and willingness to draw on contacts as appropriate

We also fundraise for causes in the UK that meet our charitable aims and for TPRF, to support its food for People programmes and other global humanitarian programmes in times of need.
